Description: The University of South Carolina will award Palmetto Boys' State Scholarships to two students in the incoming freshman class. These awards are worth \$1,500 per year and are renewable for three consecutive years. Students must maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA per year and not miss a Fall or Spring semester. To be considered, students must be graduates of Palmetto Boys' State, apply to the University by December 1, and be accepted. No separate scholarship application is required. Recipients will be notified by mail in March.

Qualifications: Palmetto Boys' State graduates are considered based on high school grades and SAT or ACT scores.

Description: Presidential and Deans Scholarships will be awarded to Boys' State participants who are interested in attending Voorhees College. The Presidential Scholarship will cover up to the cost of tuition, room and board. It does not include books. The Deans Scholarship will cover up to the cost of tuition. It does not include books.

Qualifications: Presidential Scholarship: High school cumulative grade point average 3.50-4.00; Rank in Top 20% of Graduating Senior Class or SAT 1000+ or ACT 21+. Students must meet two of three listed requirements. Deans Scholarship: High school cumulative GPA 3.00-3.49; Rank in Top 30% of Graduating Senior Class or SAT 900-990 or ACT 19+. Students must meet two of three listed requirements.

Description: The Palmetto Boys' State Scholarship is awarded to at least one entering freshman each year. This award is worth \$40,000 and is payable at \$10,000 per year and is renewable for three years. All graduates of Palmetto Boys' State who are accepted for admission will be considered.

Qualifications: Graduates of Palmetto Boys' State are considered based on high school grades, courses, GPA, class rank, SAT/ACT scores, activities, and recommendations.
